



VISA Instructions

TOURIST VISA

This visa can be issued to persons traveling to Brazil for pleasure or to visit friends or relatives, as long as the visitor has no intention to remain indefinitely in the country or engage in any paid activity.

COST: \$160.00

Form of Payment:

US Postal Service money order payable to: **Consulate General of Brazil**

CONSULATE DOES NOT accept cash, personal check or any other form of payment not listed above.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

PASSPORT: Original passport valid for at least 6 (six) months prior to its expiration date. The passport must have at least 2 (two) blank visa pages and be signed on page 3.

PHOTOGRAPH: Two copies of individual passport photo, full- frontal, white background.

VISA APPLICATION: One electronic visa application form

(<https://scedv.serpro.gov.br/frscedv/manterVisto.do?lang=eng#inicio>) Please, make sure to provide full information, even those supposedly not required. If you leave any field blank, we may request you to provide that information what could cause your application to be delayed or even refused. **Glue your picture (DO NOT STAPLE IT!) and applicant is to sign on the appropriate field.**

TRAVEL ITINERARY: Copy of round-trip ticket, print-out of itinerary or letter from travel agent/airline, confirming purchase of round-trip ticket, including dates of departure and return from Brazil. (For airline employees, photocopy of airline ID card)

CONSENT FORM: Applicants under 18 years of age must present the birth certificate and a notarized letter of consent signed by both parents, and/or legal guardian(s) authorizing the Consulate General of Brazil to issue a visa for the minor applicant. (ATTACHED) **Include a copy of the identification (Dr. License, Passport or Military ID) used to complete the consent form for both parents.**

PROOF OF RESIDENCY: Copy of Drivers License of State of Florida ID which shows proof of residency.

For children of Brazilian citizens, provide a notarized letter stating that the child has never been registered as Brazilian citizen in any Brazilian Embassy or Consulate, nor has never had a Brazilian passport previously.

Brazilian citizens must travel to Brazil on a Brazilian passport. Those who have renounced the Brazilian citizenship must present proof.

VISA Instructions

International Vaccination Certificate

Applicants, who have visited any of the countries listed below within the previous 90 days, must present a Yellow Fever International Certificate upon entering Brazil.

Angola, Benin, Bolivia, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cabo Verde, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Colombia, Democratic Republic of Congo, Ethiopia, Ecuador, French Guyana, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Ivory Coast, Kenia, Liberia, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Panama, Peru, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Surinam, Tanzania, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, Venezuela.

PROCESSING TIME

Plan your trip accordingly, in order to have your visa issued on time. We do not expedite visa. In case of emergency, please come in person to the Consulate with all supporting documentation. **By mail:** 15 business days. It also applies to those who submit their application in person but leave an Express mail in order to have their document returned by mail. **In person:** 3 business days.

Visas at the Counter

Applicant must reside within the Consulate's jurisdiction when applying through an agent or third party. Visa applications will be received from 10 am to 12 noon **only**. If approved, the visa will be ready for pick-up **in 3 business days**, from 3 pm to 4 pm **only**. Please note that the Consulate **does not issue same day visas**, unless in case of a documented medical emergency or official instructions from the Brazilian Government.

Visas by Mail

Please allow 15 (fifteen) business days for processing of visa application and return of passport, not including transit time. This processing time applies from the moment application is received at the Consulate.

Inquiries about the status of your visa application will only be provided if the processing time required by this Office has passed. Please confirm at the Post Office with your tracking number the exact date your application was received at the Consulate, otherwise consular officers will not be able to provide you with any information.

The Consulate will receive correspondence sent by the U.S. Postal Service as well as all courier services (address the envelope to the attention of the Visa Section). However, the Consulate will only return documents via the U.S. Postal Service Express Mail. Applicants must therefore enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope for the return of their documents.

Incomplete or incorrect applications will be returned to sender.

The Consulate will not accept envelopes which contain more than one application. Such envelopes will be returned except when the documents belong to members of the immediate family.

The Consulate is not responsible for delayed, lost or stolen mail.
